## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE *JOHN W. CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP*

1. Candidates must be a legal dependent of a current full or part-time regular employee or a retired employee of the City of Johnson City. This includes adopted children or children living within the permanent residence of the employee.
2. Grade point average achieved thus far in college should be 2.5 or higher out of a four-point scale as evidenced by transcript.
3. Candidates shall have demonstrated a good citizenship record with no prior discipline problems or serious infractions of school regulations within the school and community. This includes offenses against local, state and federal laws.
4. Must be attending full-time in classes at either **East Tennessee State University** or **Northeast State Community College**.
5. No candidate will be deprived of this scholarship because of his/her race, color, creed and/or physical impairment.
6. The Scholarship Committee shall review each application and shall make scholarship awards in its discretion based on the qualifications and needs of the applicant taking into account the following criteria:
  - Good Moral Character
  - Leadership Qualities
  - Scholastic Record
  - Seriousness of Purpose
  - Promise
  - Financial Need
